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FLRA ADJUSTS THE AREAS SERVED BY ITS REGIONAL OFFICES

The Federal Labor Relations Authority (FLRA) today announced changes in the areas served by the seven Regional Offices managed by the Office of the General Counsel (OGC).

Effective **June 16, 2014** the areas served by the Atlanta, Boston and Chicago Regional Offices will change as follows: cases arising in North Carolina, currently handled by the Washington Region, will be handled by the Atlanta Region; cases arising in Delaware, currently handled by the Washington Region, will be handled by the Boston Region; and cases arising in Missouri, currently handled by the Denver Region, will be handled by the Chicago Region. These adjustments will allow the OGC to maximize its resources and optimize the efficiency and economy of the OGC's field operations, while preserving high quality case investigations and services for the parties. The FLRA has also updated the addresses and phone numbers of the Regional Offices. An updated listing of the areas served and contact information for each Regional Office is attached.

The FLRA OGC is the independent investigative and prosecutorial component of the FLRA. Through its seven regional offices, the OGC investigates, settles, and prosecutes unfair labor practice charges, resolves representation disputes, including the conduct of secret ballot elections, and provides training to union and management representatives. The FLRA administers the labor-management relations program for 2.1 million non-Postal federal employees worldwide, approximately 1.2 million of whom are represented in 2,200 bargaining units. The FLRA provides leadership in establishing policies and guidance related to federal sector labor-management relations and resolving disputes under, and ensuring compliance with, the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute.
