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FLRA Announces Training on "Management Rights in Arbitration: The CFPB Test"

The Federal Labor Relations Authority (FLRA) is pleased to announce that it will be providing a virtual training session to explain, and discuss the application of, the Authority's framework for resolving management-rights exceptions to arbitration awards that find violations of collective-bargaining agreements. That test was established in <u>Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, 73</u> FLRA 670 (2023).
